


INTRODUCTION

The Rewa Eco Lodge is a community run fly fishing operation situated in the heart of the Guyanese Rainforest. The Rewa River is known for being home to the world's largest scaled fresh water fish, the arapaima.

The Rewa River system hosts some of the highest populations of arapaima anywhere in the world, but is also a mutli-species fishery that offers a spectacular variety of fish.

With more than 18 species of fish to target on fly, the sheer variety of fish is hard to beat. The primary target species include payara, peacock bass, arowana, wolf fish, surubi, bicuda, piranha, red pacu and off course arapaima.

THE FISHING

The fishing is done from 18ft aluminium boats equipped with 15/25hp two-stroke outboard motors. The boat rides to the various fishing areas are relatively short and comfortable.

Each day includes a short hike from the river to the ponds where the fishing takes place via well kept jungle trails. The boats are dragged to the ponds by our hard-working staff. The majority of fishing is done in these ponds or oxbow lakes that have been cut-off from the main river and a new pond will be fished every day.

Fishing days usually include two 4 hour sessions with a leisurely lunch break in between. Each trip includes 6 full days of fishing.

THE SEASONS

Because the Rewa Eco Lodge is situated in a tropical rainforest our fishing seasons are strictly limited to the dry season in the jungle.

The fall season runs from October to the end of November. This is considered the early season and fish are well rested after the long rainy season.

We run a spring season from February to the end of March. This is typically the best time for multiple species because of the low water conditions, especially on the main river.





THE TARGET SPECIES

Arapaima are found in the oxbows lakes and ponds. These air breathing fish can be seen gulping air all over these ponds and anglers frequently get shots at rolling fish. Under the correct circumstances Rewa even offers sight-fishing opportunities at laid-up fish. Arapaimna will test your gear through their brute strength and violent jumps.

Peacock bass are a common by-catch in the ponds and will provide great entertainment on lighter gear. The peacock bass are plentiful and can be targeted in a variety of ways including surface flies and poppers.

Payara are found in the main river. These hard fighting fish can be found around fast flowing water with rocky structure and provides a very different fishing experience to the anglers.

Arowana are entertaining fish that offer great sight-fishing opportunities to our anglers. These acrobatic fish will put on a spectacular aerial display when hooked. These elegant fish are found in the main river as well as the ponds.

Other species such as bicuda, haimara and surubi can also be targeted during your time at Rewa and our experienced guide team will provide guests with plenty opportunity to catch these special fish.

TACKLE REQUIREMENTS

Before your trip to Rewa you will be provided with a detailed and complete list of tackle needed to make the most of your time at the lodge. If you don't have the correct gear you can rent or purchase it directly from the Rewa Eco Lodge Fly shop.

















THE LODGE

The lodge is situated on the banks of the Rewa River and is run entirely by the local community. The community has been on the forefront of conservation and sustainable sport fishing since the lodge was established in 2005. Together with Indiffy the lodge has been protecting the fishery through fish research programs. Because the lodge is run by the community there is real incentive to keep the fishery and its surroundings healthy for future generations.

There is an abundance of wildlife at Rewa. Guests can experience incredible animal encounters such as giant river otters, jaguars and anacondas. The bird-life is also noteworthy with 193 species to be seen around the lodge and river.

The lodge offers rustic but comfortable accommodation. Anglers have individual rooms with on-suite bathrooms. The lodge runs on solar power and is entirely self-sufficient.

Laundry and turn-down service is included.

Three hearty meals are included each day.

The Laughing Arapaima Bar will cater for all your drinking needs with a selection of alcoholic and non-alcoholic refreshments.

Limited satellite internet is available during office hours.

2023 RATES

The price per angler is \$7,600.00 USD.

The price includes: In-country transfers, 2 hour charter flight into and 2 hour flight out of the region; meals and accommodation at Rewa Eco Lodge, 6 days guided fishing, the Arapaima license.

Not included in the price: Round trip airfare in and out of Georgetown, hotel accommodation in Georgetown, meals in Georgetown, alcoholic beverages, flies, and terminal tackle at Rewa Eco Lodge, gratuity for fly fishing guides, boat captains and lodge staff. A 10% gratuity is recommended.
